Notice to Members: Implementation of License Plate Recognition (LPR) & Guest/Visitor Management System (VMS)

Dear Members,

We wish to inform members that the Club will be implementing a License Plate Recognition (LPR) System at the Multistorey Car Park (two entry lanes), integrated with the Guest/Visitor Management System (VMS).

The target implementation (production) date is planned to be in mid-March 2026.

Vehicle Registration – Action Required

To ensure system readiness and a smooth implementation of the LPR system, members are kindly requested to update or register their vehicle details, as existing records in the membership system may no longer be accurate.

Registration Channels & Timeline

Until 28 February 2026, members may register their vehicle details through either of the following channels:

- a) Google Form <https://forms.gle/u4sgRFkR3pznd1Uu6> or
- b) In person at the Club Office during normal office hours or
- c) After office hours, as well as on weekends and public holidays, members may register their vehicle details at the Reception Counter.

From 1 March 2026 onwards, registration via the Google Form will no longer be available. Members are required to register their vehicles in person at the Club Office (during office hours), Reception, or Library.

Vehicle Registration Policy (LPR)

Under the current practice, each membership number (including spouse) is limited to the registration of two (2) vehicles.

With the implementation of the License Plate Recognition (LPR) system, the Club will formalise the registration of additional vehicles as follows:

- a) A maximum of two (2) vehicles may be registered per membership number (including spouse) without charge.
- b) Additional vehicles beyond the first two (2) may be registered, subject to a one-time registration fee of RM20 per vehicle.
- c) Registration of additional vehicles must be completed in person at the Club Office.

Important Notes & Member Responsibility

- a) Members who have successfully submitted their vehicle details by **28 February 2026** will be able to access the **Multistorey Car Park via the LPR system upon go-live in mid-March 2026**.
- b) Members are solely responsible for ensuring that all vehicle details submitted or registered with the Club are **accurate and up to date**. Any **false, inaccurate, or misleading information** provided during registration will be the responsibility of the member concerned, who may be required to provide clarification or explanation to the Club.

Further information on the LPR and VMS implementation, including Guest/Visitor management procedures, will be communicated in due course.
